2014-2015 Small Grant Awards

Golden Eagle Audubon Society awarded the following projects and programs small grants in the 2014 fiscal year:

- **Bird by Bird Program Support:** Financial support of the Bird by Bird classroom program and outreach efforts. Awarded \$750
- **Boise State University Graduate Research Project:** 'Consequences of a predator-driven-mismatch: how does earlier nesting by a predator affect availability of prey resources when spring is not changing?' by Shawn Smith. Funding assistance to implement field research. Awarded \$450
- **Council School District Binocular Purchase:** Assistance purchasing 10 pairs of binoculars for use at the Council Pond Project Site. Awarded \$500
- **Intermountain Bird Observatory Site Access Improvement:** Assistance with road improvements allowing public access to the Lucky Peak fall migration field station. Awarded \$500
- **Liberty Elementary Binocular Purchase:** Purchase of six pairs of binoculars for monthly wildlife walks on the Boise Greenbelt by 4th-6th grade classrooms, contributing to citizen science on Ebird. Awarded \$300
- **MK Nature Center Taxidermy Project:** Funds for the taxidermy of a Great Horned Owl and Burrowing Owl for educational display in the center. Awarded \$500
